FREE E-Learning programme for African diaspora organisations and individuals on:

The aim of this e-learning programme is to enhance the capacities and capabilities of African diaspora organisations working in development-related activities. Participants will learn concepts and skills as well as access resource materials on the three core themes of: networking; alliance-building; and policy engagement.

This 1-year e-learning programme is open to people from **African diaspora and civil society organisations** in all 27 EU member states, Norway, Switzerland, as well as 5 African pilot countries that are participating in the programme: Angola, Cameroon, Ethiopia, Morocco and Senegal.

This AEP e-learning programme is supported by the European Commission, the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) and the German Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ). Enrolled trainees who meet the assessment requirement will be awarded a Certificate of Completion. Training sessions and materials will be available in English and French.
