Macerata University

The postgraduate degree programme in *Political and International Studies, focus on International Economic and Trade Relations* is a two-year programme designed to provide students with a deep conceptual and methodological knowledge in the current system of international economic and trade relations. It is entirely delivered in English and it is specifically aimed at those students who wish to deepen the study of economic and trade relations within the legal, economic and management areas, with specific reference to Eastern Europe and Far East countries.

_ three-year bachelor's degree in Political Science as well as equivalent qualification or acquisition, during the undergraduate degree programme, of at least 6 credits (CFU) in at least 2 of the following subject areas: Historical/political and philosophy Economics/statistics, Law, Political science/sociological, Linguistic.

ADMISSION /

Applicants to the postgraduate degree programme in *Political and International Studies, focus on International Economic and Trade Relations* must hold at least a three-year (BA level) degree. A Committee will evaluate the documentation sent by candidates. Each candidate will be informed by e-mail about the result of his/her application. Non-EU students must submit a pre-enrollment application for Italian universities to the local Italian diplomatic authorities in their own countries before the prescribed deadline (between May and June). The request will then be submitted to the University in order to verify that the entry require-

ments are fully met. Admission to the Programme is contingent upon verification of the suitability of the academic qualifications by the competent Academic Offices.

TUITION FEE /

The annual tuition fee is around 1,500.00 (onethousandfivehundred Euros). Scholarships are available for foreign students based on academic and professional merits. Each year, scholarships and economic incentives will be made available from our local supporters: the Confindustria of Macerata and the Macerata Chamber of Commerce. Special scholarships are available for those students who will participate in the programme "Invest Your Talent in Italy".
