#### **Programme**

Borders can protect you. But borders can also hinder you from going somewhere... There are borders between people, between cultures, between countries, between neighbourhoods, between social groups, between music styles... – What if we turned borders into bridges...?

The main project activity will be to jointly work on the topic *border*. Our instrument for dealing with it will be streetart techniques like graffiti, cut out's and stickers. Grey walls, grey borders will change and become something that we want it to be: a bridge between people, a creative space of communication instead of a dead place of forced silence. On the basis of this idea we will colour up some walls in Dresden.

The multinational group will be accompanied by professional streetart trainers.
