Master's Studies plus Practical Semester

Mummert Foundation scholarships generally include a two-year Master's programme at the University of Cologne, the RWTH Aachen University or the German Sport University Cologne. Students spend an additional semester in management training and complete intern-

ships and other forms of work experience. The host universities are located in major German cities: Cologne, with its Cathedral, and Aachen, the City of Charlemagne. The two cities offer a wealth of tradition and a highly cosmopolitan, open-minded population, making it easy for the students to feel at home.

The University of Cologne, the RWTH Aachen University and the German Sport University Cologne

are internationally renowned top-flight German universities. They offer an unparalleled breadth of courses. Teaching and research are represented by outstanding scientists. Hence, it comes as no surprise that study places are very popular and that their graduates are in great demand in industry, management, academia and tourism, both at home and abroad.

The Value of Studying in Germany
